Daniele Zanzi is a well known landscaper and consultant in arboriculture all over the world. In 1982 he set up Fito-Consult, the first tree care Company in Italy.

In the same year he joined ISA (International Society of Arboriculture) as one of the first European arborist.

In 1994 he was the Co-founder of the ISA Italian Chapter in which he served as President from 1996 to 2000. In 1998 he was elected Chair of the European Arboricultural Council.

His main aim was to develop into Europe the new idea of Modern Arboriculture, working closely with the friend dr. Alex Shigo, as well as to introduce into Italy innovative arboricultural techniques - tree climbing, safety rules, inventory and assessment hazard trees.

In 2010 he got the bronze medal in Chelsea Flower Show for a landscape project on alpine flora — "Lights and colours of the Alps". The garden was complimented on by HRH Queen Elizabeth II.

In 2015, during the annual international ISA congress, he was awarded with the Award of Merit, the highest honor bestowed by ISA, which recognizes a career of outstanding, meritorious service in advancing the principles, ideals, and practice of arboriculture.

Author of several scientific and technical publications, he is often called as speaker in many Conferences, Seminars, national and international Congresses all over the world.
